

Homoeopathic Management of Renal Calculi with Mild Prostatic Enlargement and Genital Herpes: A Clinical Case Report

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Abstract

A 35-year-old male patient presented with renal calculi as the chief complaint since July 2023. The case started as one sided disease having few symptoms. Ultrasonography revealed mild prostatomegaly with it. Also, history of genital herpes was revealed during case taking. The patient has taken allopathic treatment with only temporary relief. So the relevance of renal calculi with mild prostatic enlargement and genital herpes in a single case lies in their clinical overlap, diagnostic complexity and homoeopathic management challenges. The case was managed by Cantharis, Berberis vulgaris and Merc.Sol and Lifestyle modifications including dietary restrictions and hydration guidance. Over a period of six weeks, the patient showed marked symptomatic improvement. Follow-up ultrasonography after fourteen weeks showed no evidence of the calculus and even normal sized prostate. There are also no symptoms of herpes. It demonstrates scope of Homoeopathy in treating multi- system, chronic case and the need for further clinical research in similar multi-morbid presentations.

Introduction

 Renal calculi, benign prostatic hyperplasia and genital herpes are common urogenital conditions, particularly affecting middle – aged and older males. Renal calculi are practice and cause of significant morbidity in our society. It is estimated that approximately 12% of the population will have a renal stone at some point in

their lives. The incidence of urinary calculi increases with age, attaining a maximum in the 30-45 years. After the age of 60 years, the prevalence decreases.

- BPH may predispose individuals to urinary tract infections and promote
 calculus formation due to urine stasis.
- Genital Herpes affects over 400 million
 people worldwide and is often
 underreported due to social stigma.
- Homoeopathy is gentle system of healing & perfectly safe to use in cases of renal stone .By following the guideline of master Hahnemann in case taking we can make a prescriptive totality and can homoeopathic prescribe proper treatment. There are many good remedies for renal calculi like Berberis Vulgaris, Calcarea Carb, Cantharis, Hydrangea Arborescens, Lycopodium Clavatum, Pareira B, Sarsaparilla, Terebinthina, Ocimum Can, Uva Ursi etc.5 Homoeopathic medicines can break down and dissolve renal stones or help them pass out and also help in relieving the agonising pain. It is also cost-effective

and minimise its recurrence. They reduce dependence over other and also surgery.⁶

Clinical findings

- Renal calculi since July 2023. (4mm calculus at mid calyx of left kidney.)
- Burning⁺⁺⁺ urination <evening⁺⁺⁺, waking on since 2023. Had taken allopathic medicine with no satisfactory improvement.
- Urine :pale yellow,3-4 times morning/night
- Mild prostatomegaly without significant post void urine.
- If doesn't drink water ,no desire to urination ,doesn't have burning
- Dull aching pain in left lumber region<jarring

• Desires : spicy , sour

• Doesn't like sweets, garlic

Ambithermal

- Dry spots of herpes on genitals.
- Eruptions of herpes < by silk materials
- Grinding of teeth at night before 2-3 years

Mentals:

- Tension of herpes on genitals
- Angry if there is garlic in food.
- Irritable +++ before eruptions of herpes



Outcome:




Figure. No. 2. USG-KUB after Treatment part
